## FENCING GUIDELINES

### Please attach to covenants and restrictions.

1. All fences must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee.

### STIPULATIONS:

- 1. Fences will be permitted provided they are approved by the Architectural Control Committee.
- 2. Only property line fences and/or patio fences will be approved.
- 3. No fences will be approved forward of the front edge of the house.
- 4. Fences must be entirely of wood no chain link no wire.
- 5. Property line solid wood fences should be constructed of a <u>maximum</u> of 1 x 12 vertical board—<u>Maximum</u> height 6' <u>minimum</u> 4'.
- 6. The only horizontal fencing allowed, will be split rail.
- 7. Fencing under 4' must be a minimum of 50% open.
- 8. Fencing must be maintained and in good repair at all times.
- 9. No painted or stained fences.
- 10. The finished side of the fence must be to the outside i.e. support rails must be inside the fence.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- 1. Install a gate which opens onto the common area.
- 2. Neighbors agree on fences between adjoining property.
